This **Intensive** will help you to understand the many factors which influence training and behaviour. The influences can be internal or external – your dog's drives, environmental enrichment, mental stimulation, the reflexes and emotions that could be triggered by this training task, the dog's health and physical condition, stressors in training, the body language and communication by which they are expressed, the intrinsic and learned rewards that will motivate your dog, difficulties in maintaining motivation, the nature of the relationship between dog and handler, handler errors in the teaching process amongst others. Each part of the Training Framework is discussed in detail, not just as a theory, but in the context of actual training case studies and workshopping of training problems.
